

Select	Incident Type	Definition	Examples
<input type="radio"/>	Abandoned Vehicle	Vehicle left for an extended period of time.	A broken down car is left on the street.
<input type="radio"/>	Animal Complaints	An incident involving an animal.	Bear in a trash can.
<input type="radio"/>	Barking Dog	Noise disturbance.	Incident involving continuously barking dogs in a residential area.
<input type="radio"/>	Code Enforcement	Illegal camping.	Campsites within the city limits.
<input type="radio"/>	Damage to Vehicle	Cosmetic damage to vehicle.	A person keys the exterior paint of the vehicle.
<input type="radio"/>	Graffiti	To use a permanent material to mark property that is not theirs.	Someone spray paints on a building.
<input type="radio"/>	Harassing Phone Call	Unwanted phone calls of an annoying, harassing or threatening nature.	Immediate hang-ups, obscene language, etc. with no known suspects.
<input type="radio"/>	Hit and Run - Non Injury	An accident where a responsible driver does not remain on scene to report it. Non-injury or minor accident.	A person leaves the scene of an accident. An accident that does not involve injuries or major damage to vehicles or property.
<input type="radio"/>	House Watch Reports	Hot sheet notices.	You are leaving on vacation and would like officers to drive by and make sure things look okay.
<input type="radio"/>	Identity Theft/Credit Card Fraud	When someone uses your personal information to obtain a credit card, etc.	Someone opens up a line of credit using your personal information.
<input type="radio"/>	Lost Property	Property that is lost or missing.	Items left at a business, etc.
<input type="radio"/>	Suspicious - not in progress	An occurrence that seems out of the ordinary.	Exchange of money and packages in dark parking lots.
<input type="radio"/>	Theft	When property is taken from you without your permission. Value is to be \$500.00 or less	Items cannot be taken from you physically. Items would be removed from your property or from common areas.
<input type="radio"/>	Threats - not in progress	An act towards someone that makes them feel unsafe.	You observed someone making threatening gestures towards someone on the street.
<input type="radio"/>	Trespassing - not in progress	A person is not in a place where they are allowed.	A person who has been caught shoplifting is not allowed back in the store.
<input type="radio"/>	Vehicle Burglary	Vehicle is entered and no damage is made to vehicle and no items taken.	An unlocked vehicle is entered but no property is taken.
<input type="radio"/>	Wanted Person	Fugitive from justice.	Someone has failed to appear at their court appearance.
